## LABEL MARKING CHANGES

To: Applicants AMCXC, AOTXC, APOUC, DAYRC, SYZVC, UUKLC, UXKVC, ALVYC

This bulletin is to announce marking changes to the product identity for products Listed under the product categories noted above.

ULC previously announced modified product identity text for products Listed under the UOXXC, UOJZC, UTOUC and NBSXC product categories. As there are products that are Listed to multiple product categories, it is necessary to modify the product identity for those products that have complementary product certifications.

So as not to affect the label text for existing products that are Listed only to the product categories noted above, ULC will take a phased approach in making the changes to allow you sufficient time to adapt to the changes.

## **Phased Implementation**:

For those products that are complementary Listed to UOXXC, UOJZC, UTOUC and NBSXC, ULC will adopt the simplified product identity of "Fire Alarm Equipment", "Fire Alarm Subassembly". "Security Equipment" or "Security Subassembly".

ULC will allow till **December 31, 2014** to change over existing Label text to the simplified product identity. ULC may opt to send out annual reminders of the transition.

Effective **January 1, 2015**, all Product Identities must comply with the simplified product identities.

To assist in the seamless transition to the new Marking requirements, ULC has amended the existing LMDP's (Listing Mark Data Pages) for the CCN's listed above allowing the use of either of the Product Identities.

- Existing Product or
- Alternate Product Identity (simplified)

Please refer to the LMDP's for the details by category.

All new products Listed after **November 1, 2011** to the subject product categories will, however, adopt the simplified product identities.
