Third Edition of CAN/ULC-S615-14

STANDARD FOR REINFORCED PLASTIC UNDERGROUND TANKS FOR FLAMMABLE LIQUID AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS,

ULC Standards is pleased to announce the development of the Third Edition of CAN/ULC-S615-14 Standard for **REINFORCED PLASTIC UNDERGROUND TANKS FOR FLAMMABLE LIQUID AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS**

These requirements cover reinforced plastic *non-pressure tanks* that are used for underground storage of flammable and combustible liquids such as gasoline, diesel fuel, oxygenated motor fuels, aviation fuel, fuel oil, and lubricating oil. These tanks may be recognized for use with other products where the tanks have been investigated for such products.

As a standards development organization (SDO) recognized in Canada as having the competence to develop National Standards of Canada, ULC is among the SDOs whose standards development work is eligible for funding from the Standards Council of Canada (SCC). SCC funding is specifically slotted for the review and update of various technical standards maintained by SCC-accredited SDOs that are referenced in Canadian federal regulations and which have been confirmed by government departments as being of ongoing significance to their regulatory mandates.
