STANDARD FOR NONMETALLIC TANKS FOR OIL-BURNER FUELS AND OTHER COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS

The ULC Committee on Stationary Nonmetallic Storage Containers for Flammable and Combustible Liquids, is beginning the process of developing a brand new standard, CAN/ULC-S670, Standard for Nonmetallic Tanks for Oil-Burner Fuels and Other Combustible Liquids.

The proposed first edition standard will be based on the requirements of the Second Edition ULC/ORD-C80.1-12, of the same title. It is intended to cover the requirements for nonmetallic or composite single wall, double wall or secondarily contained tanks up to a maximum of 2500 L for the aboveground storage and supply of heating fuel for oil burning equipment. Alternatively, the tanks may be used for the storage of diesel fuels for compression ignition engines and motor oils in automotive service stations.

In order to proceed with this new project, ULC Standards is now calling for volunteer members to participate in the development of this new Standard. Potential members are expected to actively participate and attend meetings. Every effort shall be made to conduct "virtual" meetings.
