## STANDARD FOR REFURBISHING OF STORAGE TANKS FOR FLAMMABLE AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS

ULC Standards is pleased to announce the publication of the First Edition of CAN/ULC-S676, Standard for Refurbishing of Storage Tanks for Flammable and Combustible Liquids. This National Standard of Canada was developed through the sponsorship of the Standards Council of Canada. It was approved by the ULC Committees on Stationary Steel, and Nonmetallic, Storage Containers for Flammable and Combustible Liquids, and is published under the date of June 2015.

This Standard covers the refurbishing of shop fabricated tanks built to nationally recognized Standards. This Standard provides minimum requirements for the inspection, evaluation and refurbishing of steel and fibre reinforced plastic underground and aboveground storage tanks and integral appurtenances designed to contain flammable liquids or combustible liquids, under atmospheric pressure. This Standard addresses the refurbishing of tanks in a refurbishing company's facility, the refurbishing of tanks at their installed location, and also provides inspection criteria for aboveground tanks that are subject to frequent relocation.

This first Edition of CAN/ULC-S676 contains:

- Requirements for safety considerations and the roles of refurbishing companies and their staff;
- Requirements for cleaning and inspection, evaluation and repairs;
- Requirements for the refurbishing of tanks at their installed location;
- Inspection criteria for the frequent relocation of aboveground tanks.

CAN/ULC-S676 is currently being considered for reference in the National Fire Code of Canada and other Codes and Regulations.
