To: Subscribers/Listees to ULC's Listing Service for Visual and Visual-audible Signal Appliances, Fire Alarm, Including Accessories, UEESC

Subject: Harmonization of Visual and Visual-audible Signal Appliances, Fire Alarm, Including Accessories, UEESC with Audible-signal Appliances Certified for Canada ULSZ7; Visual-signal Appliances for Fire-protective Signaling Systems, UVAV7; and Speakers for Fire-protective Signaling Systems, UUMW7

UL as an enterprise is striving to offer to its customers combined Canadian Certification Directories. In doing so, Underwriters Laboratories of Canada Inc. (ULC) and UL LLC are harmonizing their Canadian Certification categories in order to come up with a single Canadian Listing Directory for certified (Listed) products.

Consequently, UL is harmonizing the certification category Visual and Visual-audible Signal Appliances, Fire Alarm, Including Accessories, UEESC with the certification category Audible-signal Appliances Certified for Canada ULSZ7; Visual-signal Appliances for Fire-protective Signaling Systems, UVAV7; and Speakers for Fire-protective Signaling Systems, UUMW7, as appropriate. As the category UEESC is being harmonized, the Product Listings that are currently certified under UEESC will now be under ULSZ7, UVAV7 and UUMW7, as appropriate.

Products certified to CAN/ULC-S525 will be Listed under ULSZ7. Products certified to CAN/ULC-S526 will be Listed under UVAV7. Products certified to CAN/ULC-S541 will be Listed under UUMW7. Combination products, such as horn/strobes will be Listed under multiple categories.

The harmonized categories will represent manufacturers who received authorization from ULC and UL LLC to use their respective marks for Canada.

There are certain administrative activities that are taking place; one such activity is harmonizing the Category Control Numbers (CCN's, an internal terminology used for tracking) resulting in a combined Canadian Listing Directory. Any necessary revisions to your File will be notified and will be at no charge to you. We anticipate completing this transition by December 20, 2017.
