Second Edition CAN/ULC-S531-02 French Edition

STANDARD FOR SMOKE ALARMS / NORME SUR LES AVERTISSEURS DE FUMÉE

The Second Edition CAN/ULC-S531-02, Standard for Smoke Alarms, including Amendment 1, issued in February, 2011, was published in French with the following title: Normes détecteurs de fumée. This was a translation error that was corrected in the Third Edition CAN/ULC-S531-14. The correct title is: **Norme sur les avertisseurs de fumée**.

All references to détecteurs de fumée (smoke detectors) in the French version of the Standard CAN/ULC-S531-02 were intended to refer to avertisseurs de fumée (smoke alarms). There is no change in the technical requirements of the Standard.

CAN/ULC-S531 sets forth requirements for smoke alarms (avertisseurs de fumée), singlestation and multiple-station type, rated 120 V or less, intended for open area protection in ordinary indoor locations.
