Withdrawal of ORD and Certification program for ULC/ORD-C1058.5-2004, Halon and Halocarbon Clean Agent Recovery and Reconditioning Equipment

Underwriters Laboratories of Canada has reviewed the subject ORD (Other Recognized Document) and has decided to withdraw this document with no replacement.

Effective January 16, 2018, ULC has discontinued the Testing & Certification of Halon and Halocarbon Clean Agent Recovery and Reconditioning Equipment and ULC/ORD-C1058.5-2004 is withdrawn.

ULC reviews its certification programs on an ongoing basis and the decision to exit was driven by business needs.

ULC Standards will continue to work with stakeholders to facilitate the development of consensus based standards. Should the stakeholders be interested in proposing standards development in this area, a New Work Item Proposal would need to be submitted to ULC Standards.
