Withdrawal of ORD and Certification program for ULC/ORD-C123, Guide for the Investigation of Torches, Oxy-Fuel Gas

Underwriters Laboratories of Canada has reviewed the subject ORD (Other Recognized Document) and has decided to withdraw this document with no replacement.

Effective September 14, 2018, ULC has discontinued the Testing & Certification to Guide for the Investigation of Torches, Oxy-Fuel Gas, ULC/ORD-C123 and the ORD is withdrawn.

ULC reviews its certification programs on an ongoing basis and the decision to exit was driven by business needs.

ULC Standards will continue to work with stakeholders to facilitate the development of consensus based standards. Should the stakeholders be interested in proposing standards development in this area, a New Work Item Proposal would need to be submitted to ULC Standards.
