STANDARD FOR SAFETY OF PREMISES, BUILDINGS AND EQUIPMENT UTILIZED FOR THE CULTIVATION, PROCESSING AND PRODUCTION OF CANNABIS

ULC Standards is pleased to announce the publication of the First Edition of CAN/ULC-S4400:2018, Standard for Safety of Premises, Buildings and Equipment Utilized for the Cultivation, Processing and Production of Cannabis. This Standard has been approved by the ULC Standards Technical Committee on Cannabis, ULC TC-S4400, and has been published under the date of March 29, 2019.

This Standard establishes a minimum level of protection and safety of occupants, buildings or parts thereof, which are utilized for the cultivation and ancillary activities associated with cannabis plants and cannabis products. It provides minimum requirements for devices, equipment, and systems utilized for cannabis cultivation and ancillary activities and addresses the risks of fire, electric shock, injury to persons and explosion associated with these devices, equipment and systems. The Standard also provides minimum requirements for the security of premises from intrusion and infiltration, as well as considerations for secure access and safe egress.
