The requirements for ULC/ORD-C142.14 Nonmetallic Bulk Containers for the Storage and Dispensing of Combustible and Non-Combustible Liquids have now been included in the new First Edition of ANSI/CAN/ULC-2152:2021, Special Purpose Nonmetallic Containers and Tanks for Specific Combustible or Noncombustible Liquids.

Current Listings to ULC/ORD C142.14 will remain active until the effective date, however, any new model requests and any new Listees must be evaluated to ANSI/CAN/ULC-2152. The Guides Cards will reflect this transition and coincide with the initiation of the Industry File Review (IFR). ULC/ORD C142.14 and ANSI/CAN/ULC-2152 will co-exist till completion of the IFR. Once all files are reviewed and it is established that current Listed products comply with ANSI/CAN/ULC-2152, the ORD will be withdrawn.

The effective date for ANSI/CAN/ULC-2152 has been set as May 26, 2024 and since the requirements are contained in this new Standard, effective immediately, ULC/ORD-C142.14 stands superseded for new work investigations.

ULC will continue to provide Testing and Certification services to the new Standard ANSI/CAN//ULC-2152:2021.
