This bulletin announces a change to the service offerings in accordance with the Quebec MSP Guide.

UL has offered in-service pump training and vehicle attestation services in the province of Quebec under the Ministère de la Sécurité publique, Guide d'application relatif aux véhicules et accessoires d'intervention à l'intention des services de sécurité incendie (Quebec MSP Guide). Effective August 9th, 2021, UL will no longer offer annual pump training as required by the Quebec MSP Guide.

In addition and effective immediately, UL will also only perform a “reconnaissance de conformité” test at a facility that subscribes to UL’s factory audit program and when witnessed by a representative of UL. Furthermore, UL will no longer provide these services in the field or at an un-authorized manufacturing locations. A list of the authorized manufacturing locations can be found at [UL Product iQ](#)
