ULC periodically reviews its programs and services. As a result of comments received from our Technical Committees and applicable industry interests regarding the subject items, ULC Fire and Security Service Solutions (FSSS) has determined a need for the following changes in the Intrusion Alarm, Protective Signalling Systems, Fire Alarm, Integrated Systems Testing, Managed Video Monitoring, and Alarm Response Guard programs.

ULC FSSS will no longer issue Certification Bulletins that pertain to the adoption of a new or revised edition of an applicable Standard or ORD utilized by a ULC Certificate Services Program for its set of minimum performance requirements.

This, additionally, follows changes from the ULC Standards Organization to no longer publish Standards Bulletins, which formerly announced new editions of Standards, and to change the naming conventions for Standards to reflect all amendments now as new editions.

To this regard, all listees shall ensure that they have means in place to ensure notification of the publication of new editions of Standards that are employed by their listing category(s).

Listees and the ULC Certificates that they have issued are now required to be in conformance with the requirements of the latest edition of the applicable program Standard or ORD at all times; and within a minimum of one year following a publication of a new or revised edition, unless a Certification Bulletin is issued for an exception covering a change in a requirement(s) for which an extended time frame is being allocated.



The program changes will become effective immediately.
